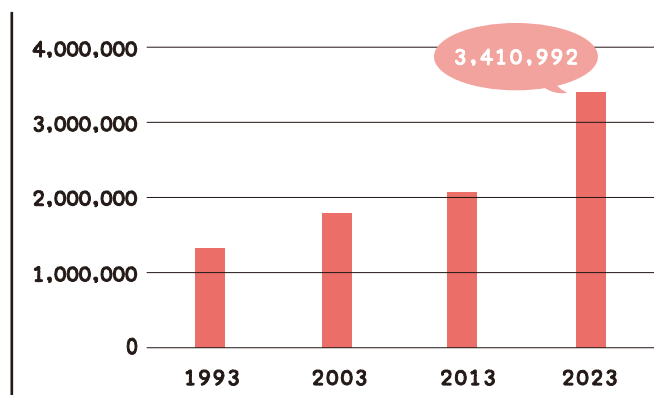

The Three Visions for a Society of Harmonious Coexistence with Foreign Nationals

1 Safe and Comfortable Society

A society built together with foreign nationals. A society where all people can live safely and comfortably.



2 Diverse and Vibrant Society

A vibrant society in which people from different countries and cultures can fully participate and contribute.



3 Society that Respects Individual Dignity and Human Rights

A society in which the dignity and human rights of all people are respected, and all are free from discrimination and prejudice.



The Four Medium- to Long-Term Issues to be Addressed

Create opportunities for foreign nationals to learn Japanese language and culture to enable them to participate more actively in society.

Communicate more information to foreign nationals and make it possible for them to seek advice on various matters.

Provide support tailored to each person's lifestyle.



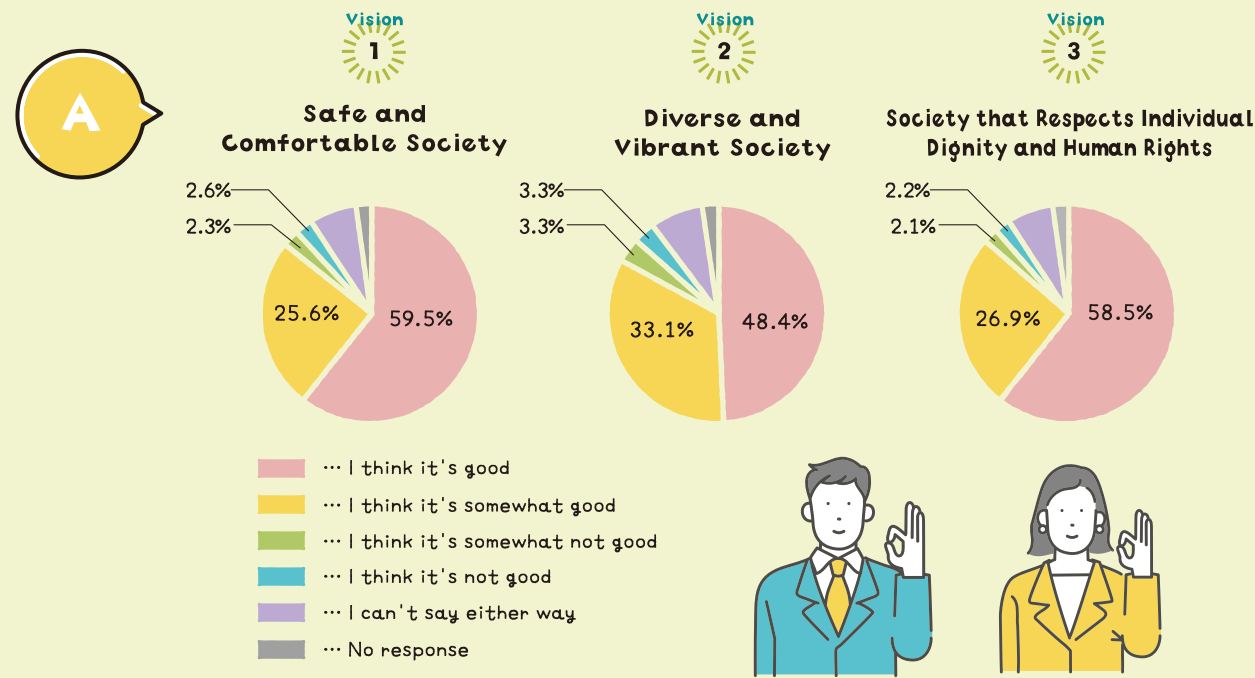

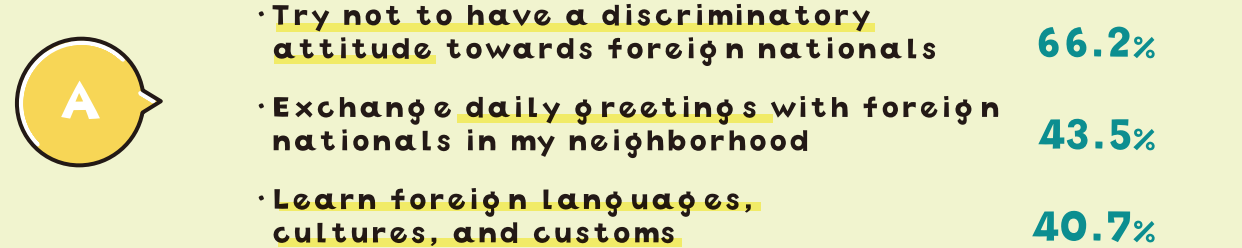

Building a society of harmonious coexistence with foreign nationals requires both Japanese people and foreign nationals to have an awareness of building society together.

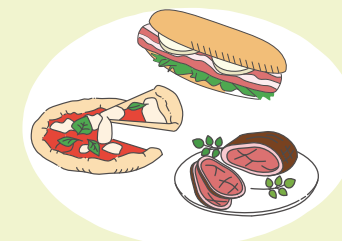
That is why we have designated every January as "LIFE IN HARMONY PROMOTION MONTH," and carry out various initiatives.

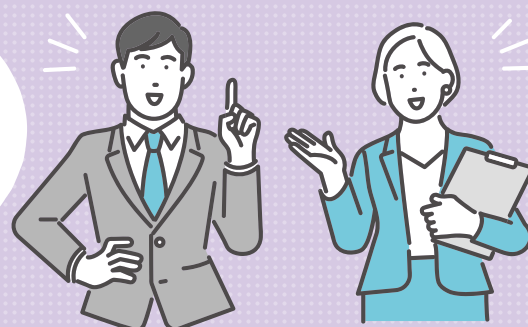
Support Coordinator for Foreign Nationals provides support to foreign residents who are facing problems living in Japan!

What is a Support Coordinator for Foreign Nationals?

We provide support in consultations from foreign nationals who face problems in their lives.



We prevent problems by providing accurate information at daily life orientations.

Support Coordinator for Foreign Nationals provides accurate information to foreign nationals and supports them to prevent problems.

When foreign nationals face problems, they can receive some advice to solve problems.

The immigration Services Agency started training program to develop Support Coordinator for Foreign Nationals in August 2024.

They will work at your local Information Counter for foreign nationals.

For Local Government Agencies

When foreign nationals face problems in their daily lives in Japan, it is not always easy for them to find information on their own or to ask someone for help.

That is why we provide subsidies to local government agencies to establish and operate consulting counters that provide essential information for everyday life in many different languages.

For employers of foreign nationals

To protect employees from injury at work, employers are required to give special training to the employees at the timing of hiring and giving them another kind of task. Employers need to make sure their foreign employees understand the training. For this, the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare provides training materials in several languages or made audiovisually for free.

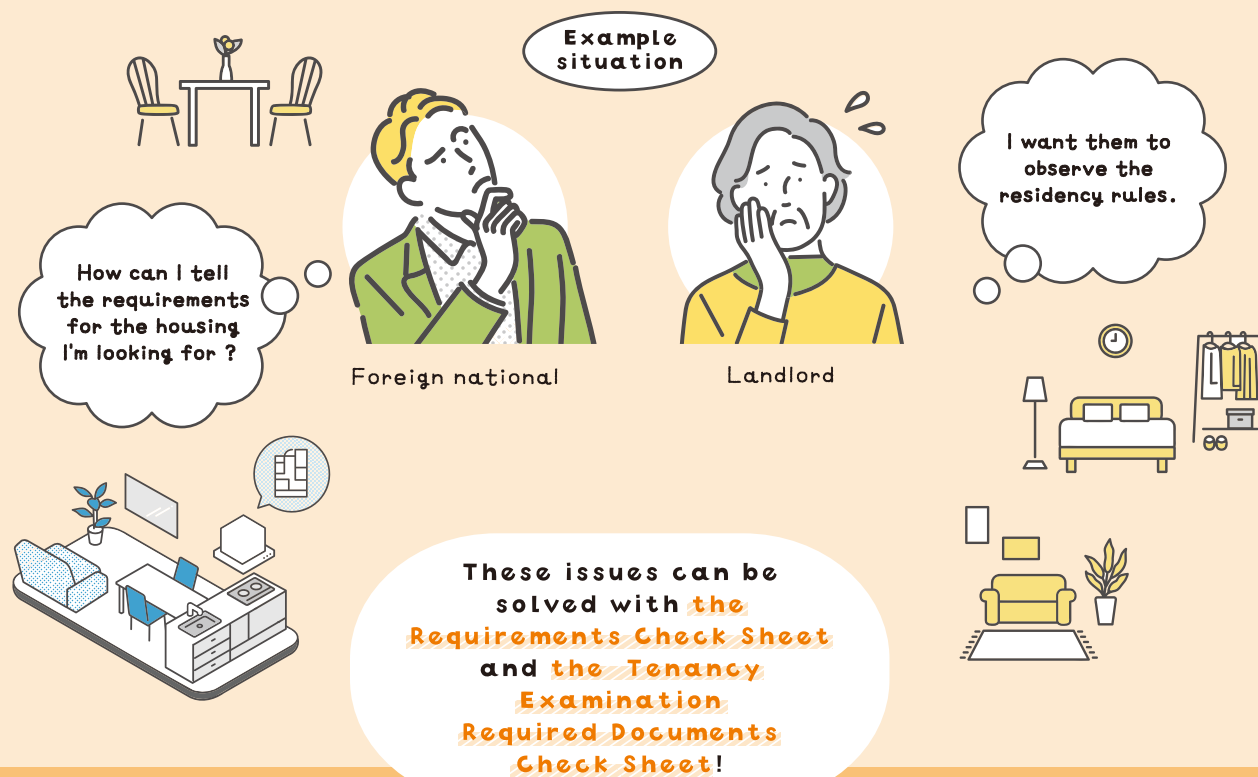

All people living in Japan between the ages of 20 and 59, including foreign nationals, have to enroll in the National Pension. On the Japan Pension Service website, you can read explanations and notices about the pension system in English and plain Japanese.
