






Creating a society where both Japanese and foreign nationals can live and shine.






Do you feel that the number of foreign nationals working in Japan has increased?





What do you expect from foreign nationals working in Japan?









The immigration Services Agency started training program to develop Support Coordinator for Foreign Nationals in August 2024.









For employers of foreign nationals



To protect employees from injury at work, employers are required to give special training to the employees at the timing of hiring and giving them another kind of task.

Employers need to make sure their foreign employees understand the training. For this, the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare provides training materials in several languages or made audiovisually for free.
